GENERAL INFORMATION

WHERE TO GO

The event will be held at Central Energy Trust Arena, 61 Pascal Street, Palmerston North (see reverse for map).

WHERE TO PARK

There is a carpark right next to Arena 2 called the "Marist Carpark", this holds up to 98 cars, there is also plenty of street parking surrounding the venue and further parking beside the B&M Centre.

HELP DESK AND REGISTRATIONS

The registration desk will be in the foyer of the building. Any lost property will be sent to the help desk and will remain at the venue after the event.
