I am looking forward to an exciting start to Term 2 and the rest of the year.

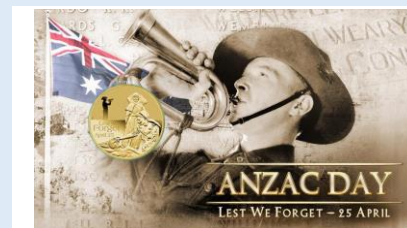

Also we are still in need of a secretary...

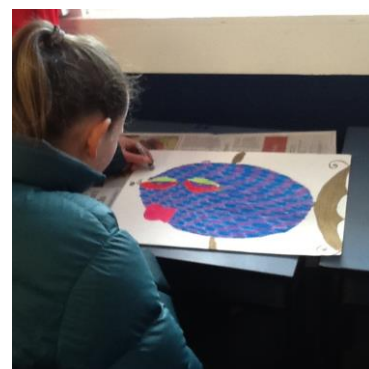
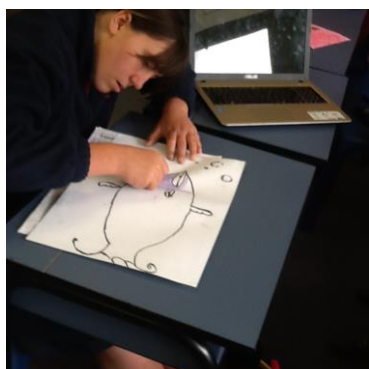

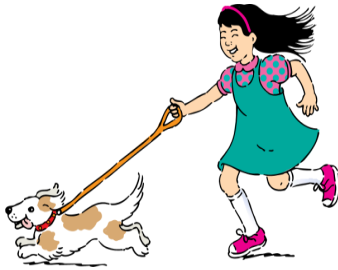
