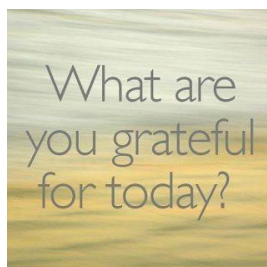
Maxine Walshe has been doing a fabulous job of taking the Choices Programme with the Year 7/8 students. Their class Taiaha is looking impressive.

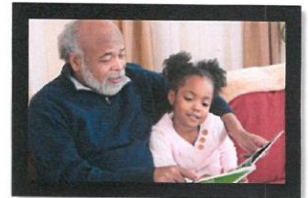
